Since its formation in 1995, **Cardiac Risk in the Young (CRY)** has been working to reduce the frequency of young sudden cardiac death. CRY promotes and develops [heart screening](#) programmes and funds medical [research](#), publishes and distributes medical information written by leading cardiologists for the general public and funds specialist referral, screening and cardiac pathology services at leading UK hospitals.

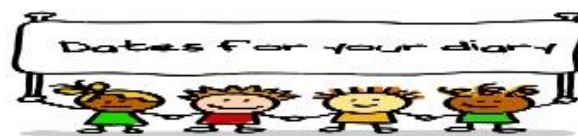
