# LEARNING AT CHARFIELD



Beetles learning this week:

Wow! What an amazing term we are having in Beetle class. Our topic this term is Amazing Africa. We started our topic by researching interesting facts about this continent and sharing them with the rest of the class.





We have studied the work of David Shepherd, who was a British artist and passionate conservationist, and created pictures of lions using various techniques.

In science, we have been studying animal skeletons and movement. To begin our topic we were set a challenge to see what we already know about our bodies. We had to correctly arrange the bones and organs to create a new member of Beetle class. We now have three new members of Beetle class:

Angus Junior, Dafydd and Harry.



The good news is that they are very well behaved and friendly!

We have also been learning about three different types of skeletons: endoskeletons, exoskeletons and hydrostatic skeletons. We then sorted different animals according to their skeletons. In groups, we painted animals from each group.

In English, we are reading The Butterfly Lion. But what is a Butterfly Lion? The children predicted what they thought it was before we started reading the story.

We have written for various purposes this term such as a diary entry, letter, persuasive holiday

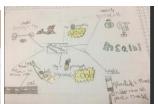
brochure and a fact file.

We are always keen to edit and improve our writing. We use a purple polishing pen to edit our own learning and respond to feedback.



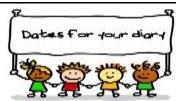
In maths, we have been converting between different units of measure. We created our own posters and used practical resources to help us remember how to convert between different units.
