





## OLYMPIC HISTORY

Artistic gymnastics was introduced at the very first Olympic Games in 1896 in Athens, and has been present at every edition of the Games since then. At the beginning, it comprised disciplines that are difficult to qualify as 'artistic', such as climbing and acrobatics. The foundations of the Olympic gymnastics programme were laid at the 1942 Games in Paris, when the men's apparatus individual and team competitions appeared. In 1928, women were included in the Amsterdam Games.
